




Exercise Programs





Tree of the Month - Pine

Pines are conifer trees or shrubs that are prized for their crisp, refreshing scent. They are the largest type of conifer, with 187 different species. These hearty trees can survive in a wide range of climates, from deserts to rainforests. and do well in subpar soil. However, they thrive best in mountainous areas with ample rainfall and favorable soil. Not only are pines flexible enough to bend with and endure large snowfalls but they also are resistant to fire. Pinecones protect the plant's seeds from harsh weather conditions. Pines are fast-growing, longlived trees that are a popular



choice for landscaping, timber, and Christmas trees. These trees are especially good at preventing soil erosion and providing windbreaks. Pines can live between 100 to more than 1,000 years. The oldest living pine, a Great Basin bristlecone named Methuselah, lives in Inyo National Forest in eastern California and is over 4,800 years old.

Flower - Holly



December's flower is the hearty, vibrant holly plant. Its bright red berries and glossy, deep green leaves have come to symbolize the winter holiday season, and

particularly Christmas. Holly also symbolizes truth, protection, fertility, and eternal life. In fact, some holly trees live up to 400 years. Holly grows in temperate and subtropical climates. Its berries are slightly toxic to humans but can be eaten by birds. Some types of holly leaves are used to make tea.

Turquoise has been valued for its tremendous beauty for thousands of years. Archaeologists have discovered turquoise jewelry on the mummified bodies of gueens

in Egyptian tombs and in ancient burial sites in Argentina, Peru, and Mexico. The Inca used the stone to craft beads and figurines, while the Aztecs used it to make pendants and ritual masks. The Chinese were carving it for decorative art over 3,000 years ago. Turquoise is also often used as a love charm.
